

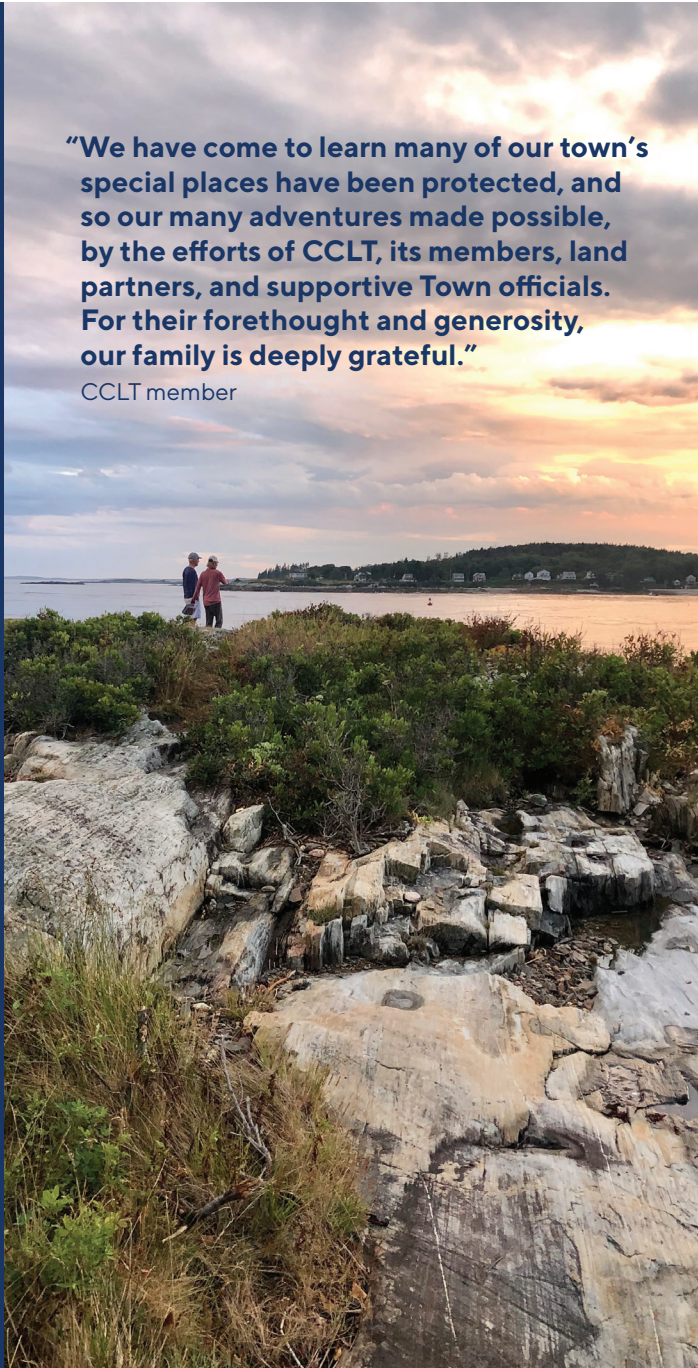
# Stewardship
