CAMPAIGN FOR

Read Family Farm & Woods



CCLT has embarked on a campaign to protect 54 acres of land on the south side of Blanchard Road in Cumberland Center. The property consists of 7 acres of open field and 47 acres of forest connecting to other conserved areas.

The property contains a variety of essential habitats including a field used actively for local agriculture; a large block of intact, upland forest; and a variety of wetland types including streams and forested wetlands.

In addition to protecting the property from future subdivision and development, the conservation easement will allow CCLT to install a small parking area adjacent to Blanchard Road and create and maintain trails for non-motorized recreation in the forested portions of the property and to connect to Rines Forest.

Your donation toward this project will help:

- Protect 54 acres of land less than half a mile from Cumberland Center
- Provide a critical recreation and habitat linkage to the north and south as part of multi-town green conservation corridor from Hadlock Forest (330 acres in Falmouth) through Rines Forest (306 acres in Cumberland) to Knight's Pond area (334 acres in Cumberland and North Yarmouth)
- Support active local agriculture and working woodlands. The landowner intends to lease the fields to a farmer for agricultural use. The forests will be sustainably harvested by the landowner for forest products and to promote the health of the woodlands.
- Protect an admired scenic viewshed along Blanchard Road

"Dr. Frank Read purchased this land in 1984 to prevent a housing development from being built there. Our family has since spent many long afternoons roaming those woods and meadows, and now we have decided to permanently conserve the property with CCLT so that others may do the same, in perpetuity."
